SCCPSS Board Update

Safety is one of his main priorities in the short term, and while much work has been done, we are looking at enhancements at many schools, including May Howard that include:

1. Safety/entry vestibules (May Howard has one already)
2. Classroom door locking mechanisms
3. More rigorous visitor entry protocols
4. Cameras
5. And for Shawn, he wants to have an armed SRO and metal detector entry at every school in the District
6. Other enhancements are also in the works

In addition, we are finishing up the new play field, outdoor classroom and road behind/adjacent to Marshpoint, and the next project is the competition level soccer/football/lacrosse field and track that will go in across from the library south of Islands to which all schools will have access.
